

## **Binkley Outdoor Summer Camp**

**Binkley Preschool** is offering **2,** Outdoor Summer Camp options for children ages 3-5 (including our rising 3's with summer birthdays). All campers must be **FULLY POTTY TRAINED** and have some preschool or group activity experience to attend camp. This year's camp options are as follows:

Option #1, 10 (TEN) camp days, May 27<sup>th</sup> to June 9<sup>th</sup> for \$315 (\$7.87/hour) or 5 (FIVE) camp days (M-F), June 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> for \$185 (\$9.25/hour). These camps rates are for children who are currently enrolled or are enrolled for the 2020-2021 school year.

The cost for children from the general public is \$350/ten day (\$8.75/hour) and \$205/M-F (\$10.25/hour), per session. There is a \$10.00 application fee per application for all students. All tuition and fees are due at sign up. No refunds will be given.

This is an excellent way for your child to get acquainted with new friends, teachers, currently enrolled children, and neighborhood friends! In this packet, you will find the necessary information to help you make your decision. Please read all of the information in this packet carefully!

#### Space is available on a first-come basis with a maximum of 18 kiddos.

We will have a wait list after the first 18 and will hire a teacher(s) for every 8 children after that. If fees are not paid with your application we will move someone from the waitlist and you will lose your spot.

# \*\*\*Please return your camp forms and fees to the mailbox on Mrs. Buckley's door.\*\*\*

Once your application and fees have been collected, your child's name will be added to a roster hanging in the glass case at the end of the hallway.

#### You are ONLY officially enrolled when:

- 1. You have paid ALL TUITION AND FEES, which are due at sign up.
- 2. Completed application form, health form and emergency contact form (for all campers) and a physician completed Physical and Immunization form (general public only) are returned to the BPS office. If your child is currently enrolled at Binkley Preschool an existing health form will suffice. Binkley Preschool does not accept vaccination exemptions based on statements of religious belief and opposition to the immunization requirements.
- 3. Your child's name is added to the roster, hanging in the glass case, in the BPS hallway.

#### NO REFUNDS and NO ADDITIONAL CONFIRMATION WILL BE SENT OUT.

### **Additional Camp Information**

Binkley Summer Camp is a separate program from Binkley Preschool. Binkley Summer Camp is a true "summer camp". Most of the programming takes place outside. While there is certainly a routine and a schedule, it will be different than our typical preschool day. Current BPS students should not expect the same schedule, their current teachers, classmates or classrooms. We are not set up for diaper changing so all children MUST be potty trained. For the purposes of summer camp, "potty trained" means being able to recognize the need to go in a timely fashion, get up onto the toilet, pull pants up and down and handle personal hygiene. Pull-ups are not allowed. **More than two accidents will result in dismissal and loss of all fees.** 

BPS Summer camp runs from 9a-Ip daily. Children bring snack and lunch from home. Traditional camp foods such as s'mores and popsicles may be part of camp curriculum. If you note an allergy or food restriction on the enclosed health form, we will ask you **before** your child participates in these activities.

As with any summer camp, children are expected to be independent. Now is a great time to help your child learn important camp skills. Recognizing belongings, packing them into a backpack and managing a lunch box are challenging yet, confidence building. However, these skills take practice. If these are skills your child has yet to master, we ask that you begin helping your child learn them now.

And finally, we plan and staff summer camp, based on the number of campers that we have registered. If your plans change or if you have anticipated that your child will be potty trained (defined above), but s/he is not, then please NOTE that ALL CAMP TUITION and FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.
